

### **FAMILY NOTES**

**Engagement (19 November 1842):** The three Banns were held on the 5th, 12th and 19th November 1842. 12 shillings were paid for the Charta Sigillata (stamped document for official use).

Marriage (31 December 1843): Shelly visited Dalhem Kyrka, 13 Jul 2005. The church was built in 1878 and replaced an earlier church where Jonas and Lena were married in 1843. The newer church contains some artefacts from the previous church: ceiling chandeliers, candelabra on either side of the alter, wall hangings and a collection box. Some vestments were moved to the State Museum in Stockholm.

General:

## **FATHER NOTES: Jonas Petter Carlsson**

**Birth (19 October 1816):** Shelly Robert Johnson visited Dånhult in 2003 and on 14 Jul 2005 and prepared photographs. An historical marker is present and is inscribed as follows: "Jonsbo, Sista[last] Brukare[farmer], Gottfrid och Justin A Karlsson, Rivet [house demolished] 1946". Jonas Petter's father, Carl Magnus Jonsson, was a farmer here.

Dånhult (Coordinates: DANHLT, N 57 57.473', E 16 01.155') now contains two farm sites, approximately 300 yards apart, both with farm buildings and a house. A very narrow road resembling a driveway connects them. Along this road is evidence of apple and cherry trees and raspberry or boysenberry vines. Fields nearby may have produced crops. The road leading to Dånhult is a branch of the main road to Ekhult, and it ends at the first farm known as Jonsbo farm [Lilla Jonsbo is a different farm], the place believed to be Jonas Petter's birth

place. The site is on the top of a hill on the west side of Lake Fälen. Behind the house about 75 yards away are piles of rocks that may have been part of the floor of a house, perhaps the Jonsbo torp. Also present is a large disk-like rock with a hole through the center, function unknown. Beside the house, about 100 feet away is a large barn. Both may be about 150 years old. From the farther farm [name not determined, but it may be Dånhult] site there is a narrow road that seems little used and also leads to Ekhult."We think Jonas Petter is born here [Jonsbo torp or torpet Jonsbo], but we are not sure yet." (Rosita Johnsson). His birth record for 1816 is not available on Genline.com or FHL.

Residence (1825): Rosita writes the following: Greta Lisa had four chilrdren but the names and birth dates are not known to her. "The books from the church has been burned up, so this info have we got from an other person. After 1825 the books is gone. But we know Jonas Petter Carlsson came from Hycklinge parish. We think he is born in Jonsbo very close to Ekhult. You can find the place near Dånhult. We visited the place in October. There is one house left, a house is gone. We think it was that house they lived in. Otherwise they have lived here."

Emigration (22 October 1832): This may be the move when he left his parents.

**Immigration (1839):** Komminister means assistant minister or assistant vicar.

**Immigration (after 8 November 1840):** He is listed as a Dräng.

Immigration (8 November 1841): Shelly visited Sundet, Dombra, 13 July 2005 and prepared pictures of the site which is not entered on the Green Map. The site is under care of a Dalhem historical society [exact name not known]. It is to the west of the road to Dombra and is reached by a partially overgrown narrow road that passes by small farm fields populated with some trees and foundation stones that mark several building sites on a slope about 200 meters from Antvarden Lake. One of the foundations has rocks that are cemented together where there is a marker placed by the Society. Nearby is a cellar.

**Immigration (1846):** Risefall, Risebo, Dalhem, Kalmar län, Sweden(Coordinates: RISFAL N 58 02.129", E 16 06.856'). The site is now known as Karlsson's Kulle, Rl.12 (see Map: Risebo Fritid-Stugor, Fiske and Jakt, with thumbnail picture). This two story house is rented for fishing by Fritid Risebo(Photographs: Shelly Robert Johnson, 15-24 July 2003, Sweden, roll #5 frame 3). A foundation is nearby(under the canopy) and is believed to be the site of a house occupied by Jonas. Born here were Christina(27 Feb 1844), Carolina(2 Nov 1846), and Per Johan Oscar(24 Aug 1849).

Emigration (1860): He is now a lodger, but he was formally a farmer.

Emigration (20 April 1880): Before he left he had been living as "Till Hus", a lodger.

**Emigration (7 May 1880):** The Emihamn states that he is "traveling alone," but his source number is the same as the source number for his wife Lina(sic) and daughter Emelie(sic) who are "traveling with others." His son, Svante Aug(sic) and daughter Sara Mathilda have the same Source number but he is "traveling alone" and she is "traveling with others." The meaning of these differences is not known. All five people came from Åtvidaberg and left Sweden from Göteborg on the same date aboard the SS Rollo and traveled to Hull, England. **Immigration (after 7 May 1880):** When and how they arrived in America is unknown. It appears that they did not arrive in New York. They were found in the Federal Census for Hastings, Minnesota on June 14, 1880. A sixth person may have traveled with them. On the line preceding Jonas's name [Contract #1347] is a F. E. Lindgren, male, age 22, also from Åtvidaberg and who traveled to Hastings, Minnesota, with the Contract #1346.

**Burial (after 24 June 1883):** At the Hampton Township Cemetery there is a single monument, about 4 feet high, for Jonas and his wife Lena that is in the middle between the monuments for their daughter Christina on the right and Christina's son, Elmer, on the left. The inscription for Jonas, on the west facing side, is as follows; "JONAS P. CARLSON DIED JULY 24 1883 AGED 67 (sic) [66 y 8 m 5 d] YEARS Gone home," for Lena the inscription on the east facing side is "CARLINE H DIED DEC 15 1898 AGED 76 (sic) 74 y 11 m 22 d] YEARS." The reason for the change in her given names from Lena Kajsa to Carline H is unknown. Hampton Cemetery (=Hampton Township Cemetery), is located on 225th St, and near Northfield Blvd Hampton, Dakota Co., Minnesota. It was never affiliated with a church and is now supported by a small appropriation from a local organization which is paid to its neighbor for maintenance, such as mowing the large lawn. The address of the farm next door is 5935 225th ST E, Hampton, MN 55031. Debbie Boe, In, Hampton Cemetery Burial Records, observed that "The cemetery has some regular care and is in poor shape. There is no name over the gate. Many monuments are broken, turned over and displaced."

General: NAME: "All six children born Carlsson, changed their name to Johnson [?], taken from (Jonas)", In, From Sweden and Norway to America, Johnson and Larson, Johnson Family History, Ethyl Schultz Larson, p. 1. [In Sweden none of the children's surname was Carlsson, but instead, Jonsson or Jonsdotter]

#### **MOTHER NOTES: Lena Cajsa Zachrisdotter**

**Birth (24 December 1823):** Her birth year is presented as 1824, In, Personal Knowledge: Genealogy of Edwin Albert Larson. However, 1823 is found in the Church Record for births, GID: 45.18.31500. It is not clear why 1824 is offered as the birth date. GPS waypoint

KMDALN(N 58 07.243', E 16 09.944') and picture roll#4-14 describe the location and appearance of the building where she was born. It was said to be built in 1791. There is now a stairway to the second floor bedroom that replaced the original ladder. It appears to be a house from the 1800's or earlier. The doorways are low and wooden planks make up the floors (Personal Knowledge: Lena Cajsa...). Kamdalen may be a torp.

Chr (26 December 1823): "We think she was baptized in the home." (Rosita Johnsson)

**Immigration (1839):** In 1839 she moved to the torp Måsanda, below Dombra(now known as Domra). Today it is known as Mossänder (Correspondence: letter, Rosita to Shelly Robert Johnson, 3 Nov 2003).

Emigration (7 May 1880): She traveled aboard the SS Rollo.

**Burial (after 15 December 1898):** At the Hampton Township Cemetery there is a single monument, about 4 feet high, for Jonas and his wife Lena that is in the middle between the monuments for their daughter Christina on the right and Christina's son, Elmer, on the left. The inscription for Jonas, on the west facing side, is as follows; "JONAS P. CARLSON DIED JULY 24 1883 AGED 67 (sic) [66 y 8 m 5 d] YEARS Gone home," for Lena the inscription on the east facing side is "CARLINE H DIED DEC 15 1898 AGED 76 (sic) 74 y 11 m 22 d] YEARS." The reason for the change in her given names from Lena Kajsa to Carline H is unknown. **General:** 

NAME: Her full name is presented as Lena [Kajsa] Zachrisedotter (sic) [Zachrisdotter] (Carlsson), In, From Sweden and Norway to America, Johnson and Arson, Johnson Family History, up. 1. There is a Carline H stated to be the wife of Jonas P. Carlson (sic), who was buried next to him. That name has not been observed elsewhere (See Web Site: Hampton Cemetery Burial Records, Jonas P. Carlson). In the 1880 Federal Census, Hellon instead of Lena was presented as her given name. An examination of the inscription on her monument at Hampton Cemetery shows her name spelled as Caroline H, age 76 years (sic) [actual age 74 y 11 m 21 d]. Caroline Hellon is assumed to be the name she used in America.

RESIDENCE: During the year of her first child's birth (1844) she is said to come from Risefall [this has not been observed elsewhere] (Correspondence: Letter (Swedish) to Tea Nystrom).

CHURCH: Gärdserum kyrka, wooden buildings built 1260 AD. Present structures built in 1857 partly with materials from the original building, i.e. wooden beam on display, decorative pieces and an iron door. Lena probably attended this church when a child (Photographs: Shelly Robert Johnson, 15-24 July 2003, roll #4, frames 11-13). Examined gravestones in the graveyard and leaning on wall of church, but found no evidence of relatives.

IMMIGRATION: See Immigration, 1888 for Sara Mathilda Jonsdotter for a discussion of her Lena's arrival in the USA.

#### **CHILD NOTES: Christina Sofia Jonsdotter**

**Birth (27 February 1844):** The "Descendants of Jonas Peter Carlsson(Short and Long Forms)" list the birth date as 1843, but it is not followed here. Risefall, Dalhem, is given as the birth place(Correspondence: letter, Rosita to Shelly Robert Johnson, 3 Nov 2003), but the birth record gives Dombre Sundet, 27 Feb 1844.

Emigration (24 October 1860): She is listed as a worker's daughter when she left her parents.

**Immigration (6 November 1860):** In the record, she is listed below one Dräng and four Piga and is described as a flicken, a girl, in the farm of Lars Magnus Simonsson. He has a 2/32 tax assessment, but his status is unknown.

**Immigration (1864):** The taxes were paid by a Nämndemannen, a layman judge member of a district court, who may have been Gustaf Samuelsson. A Bjässerum is located on Google Earth about 0.5 km southwest of Trångmålen and another one is located on the Green Map, 7G NV, about 0.5 km north of Österby, which is about 3.5 km northeast of Trångmålen. Norra Bjässerum was not found on either map, but it is believed that its location is near the Bjässerum on Google Earth.

**Immigration (1865):** The taxes were paid by a Nämndemannen, a layman judge member of a district court, who may have been Johan Pettersson. Elsewhere, Bjässerum refers to region which was divided later into Norra Bjässerum, Västra Bjässerun, and Östra Bjässerum. These three subregions included various villages and farms. This classification is not followed here. Norra Bjässerum is used to designate a village.

Immigration (20 May 1869): Christina Johnsdotter, line 233, Arrival Date: 20 May 1869, Estimated Birth Year: 1845 (sic) [1844], Age: 24 (sic) [25], Gender: female, Steeerage, Port of Departure: Glasgow, Destination: United States of America, Place of Origin: Sweden, Ship Name: Donau [Dorian?], Port of Arrival: New York.

Immigration (after 20 May 1869): In the Emihamn, her destintion is Galesburg, probably in Illinois, and it is not known if she arrived there, or why she chose Galesburg for her destination. It seems possible that she knew someone, possibly a relative, living in Galesburg. A year later when her brother immigrated to the USA he indicated in the Emihamn that his destination was Mt. Pleasant, probably in Illinois, about 300 miles south of Galesburg. It is assumed that this Galesburg and Mt. Pleasant are located in Illinois, both of which were Swedish settlements. A Galesburg and a Mt Pleasant may also be found in other states, but not in Minnesota. It is not known if she lived in Galesburg or when or where she married Joseph Kirk. However her only child, Elmer Kirk, was born in 1881. If she married shortly before his birth then her maiden name might be found in the 1870 Census records for Illinois or Minnesota.

**Burial (18 March 1900):** At the Hampton Township Cemetery there is a slender stone monument for Christina that extends about five feet above the ground. Inscribed is the following; "CHRISTINA S. WIFE OF JOS A. S. KIRK DIED MAR 18 1900 AGED 56 YEARS She

always made home happy. The voice he loved is stilled. KIRK." To the left of her monument is the monument for her parents, Jonas and Lena, and to their left is the monument for her infant son, Elmer. Inscribed is the following; "ELMER A. KIRK DIED MAY 22 1882 AGED 5 MONTHS Safe in the arms of Jesus." All of the inscriptions face to the west, except for Lena's inscription, which is engraved on the side opposite to Jonas's and faces east. Both Christina and her son's remains, but not the monuments, were moved on 10 June 1924 to Crystal Lake Cemetery, Minneapoplis, Minnesota.

#### General:

NAME: The name Christina Sofia Carlsson (Kirk) is presented, IN, From Sweden and Norway to America, Dec. 1979, Johnson and Larson, Johnson Family History, p. 1. This combination of names has not been found elsewhere. Christina is referred to as Carolina Sofia Jonsdotter(Correspondence: Letter (Swedish) to Tea Nystrom) and Shelly Robert Johnson is using that surname for the four sisters.

CHILDREN: Myrtle Frances Berg(Personal Knowledge: "Myrtle's & her sisters and brothers ancestrors: " states that Christine married J. A. S. Kirk and they had no children." In fact they had a son Elmer who died when six months old and an adopted daughter Mabel.

PARISH: "Ytterligare upplysningar om dem, utom Carolina se ovan!, torde inhämtas på pastorsämbetet i Åtvid, 597 00 Åtvidaberg"(Correspondence: "Letter(Swedish) to Tea Nystrom).

GRAVE MONUMENT: At the Hampton Township Cemetery there is a slender stone monument for Christina that extends about five feet above the ground. Inscribed is the following; "CHRISTINA S. WIFE OF JOS A. S. KIRK DIED MAR 18 1900 AGED 56 YEARS She always made home happy The voice he loved is stilled. KIRK." To the left of her monument is the monument for her parents, Jonas and Lena, and to their left is the monument for her infant son, Elmer. Inscribed is the following; "ELMER A. KIRK DIED MAY 22 1882 AGED 5 MONTHS Safe in the arms of Jesus." The inscriptions face to the west, except for Lena's inscription, which is engraved on the side opposite to Jonas's and faces east. Both Christina and her son's remains, but not the monuments, were later moved to Crystal Lake Cemetery, Minneapoplis, Minnesota.

### **CHILD NOTES: Carolina Jonsdotter**

Birth (2 November 1846):

Emigration (9 July 1862): She left her parents.

Immigration (20 July 1862): When she arrived in Gammalskeda she worked on the Anders Petter Pettersson farm, then later moved to the Lars Magnus Svensson farm.

Immigration (1868): She moved to the Petter Nicklas Andersson farm.

Immigration (1872): She lived with her husband who worked as an arbetare, a laborer on the farm owned by Petter Nicklas Andersson whose residence was in Öndhult, Åtvid, Östergötland. Her first two children, Carl and Amanda, were born here.

Residence (between 1876 and 1890): Her husband worked as an arbetare, laborer, on the farm owned by A. P. Pettersson. er first two children, Carl and Amanda were born here. Five more children were born during this time and three died of diphtheria in 1879. Residence (between 1891 and 1895): She lived as a lodger [inhyses] with her husband who worked [arbtare], on the Carl Alfred Bard farm. Gerda, Jonas Frans and Svanti lived there with them. Jonas and Svanti later immigrated to Minnesota, USA, where they died in 1964 and 1970, respectively

General: IMMIGRATION: Never traveled to USA(Personal Knowledge: Myrtle's and her sisters and brothers ancestors).

#### **CHILD NOTES: Petter Johan Oscar Jonsson**

Emigration (1863): He left his parents.

**Emigration (6 May 1870):** The correct birth name is Per Johan Oscar Jonasson. Per Johan is the only person with this Källkod number, 3:231:662, and he traveled alone.

**Immigration (6 June 1870):** The one month travel time from Göteborg to New York seems excessive, but may be accounted for by a long wait for his ship in Glasgow.

Immigration (after 6 June 1870): It is unknown if Per reached Mt Pleasant, the destination in his emigration records, and if or when he moved to Minnesota. However his wife was from Illinois.

**Death (1899):** Did not find Per Johan listed in the burial records for either Corinthean Cemetery or the St. Michael's Catholic Cemetery in Empire Co., MN.

**General:** NAME: Per Oscar Fodd Johnson is entered In, From Sweden and Norway to America, Johnson and Larson, Johnson Family History, p. 20. The spelling Oskar is presented in Correspondence: e-mail, 22 Dec 2002. Other names observed are Oscar Johnson, Oscar Johnson, and Per Oscar Johnson.

#### **CHILD NOTES: Sven August Jonsson**

**Birth (6 January 1855):** A birth date which is given as 1850, five years before the dates found in other sources(Church Records: Sara Matilda Jonsdotter(Berg), p. 1, is not followed here.

Emigration (1873): He left his parents.

**Immigration (7 November 1876):** Shelly Robert Johnson visited this site, 13 July 2005, and prepared ?photographs. It is a large farm with several buildings, none probably old enough for Sven August Jonsson to have lived there. On map 7G NV Västervik Måshult is spelled Mosshult.

**Emigration (7 May 1880):** A Sven Johansson, Källkod #15:47:9160, was found in the Emihamn by Rosita Johansson and she concluded that he was Sven August Johansson. A Svante Aug Johansson, Kallkod #15:60:2600 (same number as for Sara Mathilda Johansson, his sister) was found in the Emihamn and Shelly Robert Johanson has concluded he is Sven August Johanson.

**Burial:** His names were not found in the list of burials for Hampton Township Cemetery.

General: BIRTH: Myrtle Frances Berg(Personal Knowledge: "Myrtle's and her sister's and brother's ancestors:") lists Swan August, who married Lovisa and had a son Albert and a daughter named Etta, as the son of Karolina. Shelly believes this is incorrect. Sven August is the son of Lena Cajsa Zachrisdotter. Karolina had a son named August(1888) who married Gerda, and they had a daughter named Anna(1998). Karolina also had an unmarried daughter named Gerda(1879-1961).

NAME: Svante August Johnson is entered IN, From Sweden and Norway to America, Johnson and Larson, Johnson Family History, p. 1. Sven August Janson is found In, Correspondence: e-mail 22 Dec 2002, p.4. Tenth Census, 1880, gives Swan A, Johnson.

MILITARY: "Blev till soldat Kassered (he was not able to do some work in the military)" In, Church Records: 1876-1886, Sven August Jonsson, Emilia and Sara Mathilda Jonsdotter, Lilla Jonsbo.

IMMIGRATION: See Immigration, 1880, for Sara Mathilda Jonsdotter for a discussion of his arrival the USA. He probably did not arrive in New York City.

#### **CHILD NOTES: Emilia Augusta Jonsdotter**

**Birth (12 June 1858):** The birthplace is given as Åtvidaberg(Personal Knowledge: "The Swan B. Berg Family starting with Sven...), the date is given as 14 [12] June 1853 [1858] (Church Records: Sara Matilda Jonsdotter(Berg), p. 1.) and is not followed here.

Emigration (1877): She left her parents.

Name (Amelia A Larson): The 1920 Census gives her name as Amelia A. Larson.

**Burial (after 14 June 1928):** The grave is in section 41, lot 376, Lakewood Cemetery, Minneapolis, Hennepin Co., MN. The spelling of her name on her gravestone is Amelia, the spelling she used for most of her life in Minnesota.

General: CHILDREN: Myrtle Frances Berg(Personal Knowledge: "Myrtle's & her sisters & brothers ancestors:")(Personal Knowledge: The Swan B. Berg Family starting with Sven...") states that Amelia had a son named Edwin and had two other babies(a boy and a girl) who died

IMMIGRATION: See Immigration, 1880, Sarah Mathilda Jonsdotter for a discussion of her arrival in the USA. She probably did not arrive in New York City.

### **CHILD NOTES: Sara Mathilda Jonsdotter**

**Birth (1 July 1861):** The coordinates for Lilla Jonsbo, Österby, Åtvid, Östergötland län are N 58 06.36, E 16 04.882', (GPS LILJON). No buildings remain, but foundation and floor stones are evident for three buildings, including a cellar. A road bisects the site. The home site may be about 50 yards west of the road on a slight rise in elevation where there was found a rectagular arrangement of rocks, indicating a former foundation for a house. We ate wild strawberries that were growing there(Photographs: Shelly Robert Johnson, 15-24 July 2003, roll#4 frames 15-20).

Her birthplace is given as "Dalhem socken" (parish in Kalmars län and which is not followed here), IN, From Sweden and Norway to America, Johnson and Larson, Johnson Family History, p. 73, which is contrary to her Åtvid parish birth record. Under her name in the birth record is a phrase which means, "they are written in the new book."

Emigration (after 1 January 1878): She left her parents.

**Immigration (after 2 January 1878):** Kulla(Coordinates: KULLA, N 58 05.624', E 16 03.865') consists of several different farms with the buildings located on a small hill. At least one building was built in 1880. Her brother Sven August Jonsson moved to Kulla in 1873 and left in 1876, while her sister Emilia moved to Kulla in 1877 and left in 1878. Since Sara moved to Kulla in 1878, it appears that they never lived at Kulla at the same time. They worked as maids or farm workers there. It is not known if they worked in the existing buildings or their predecessors(Photographs: Shelly Robert Johnson, Sweden, roll#4 frames 21-23).

**Emigration (26 April 1880):** She may have returned to Lilla Jonsbo to join her parents, sister Emilia, and brother Sven August before traveling to Göteborg. Her name was included in her parents emigration certificate from Lilla Jonsbo (Åtvid, AI:36:36). **Residence (18 June 1880):** It is not known when she left Vermillion. She was not found in the Minneapolis City Directories for the years 1880-1897.

**Death (24 November 1901):** "Carbuncle spread to the heart..." "Mrs. Mathilda S. Berg, wife of Swan B. Perg, died Nov. 24 of percardities, at her home in Silver Creek at 5 p. m. She was born July 1, 1862 in Sweden and came to America 1880. The deceased leaves husband and 5 children to mourn their loss. (Obituary)"

**Funeral (after 24 November 1901):** "Card of Thanks. I desire to return my sincere and heartfelt thanks to Camp 3168, Modern Woodmen of America, for the beautiful flowers donated at the funeral of my beloved wife. SWAN P. BERG, Silver creek." (Newspaper: Card of Thanks by Swan P. Berg)

**Burial (after 25 November 1901):** Buried at Lot# 60-61, Lake Side Cemetery, Silver Creek, Wright Co., Mn (Lake Side Cemetery, Minutes of the first meeting ...1889).

**Burial (1944):** Her remains were moved to Lakewood Cemetery, Minneapolis, MN, Swan Berg family plot, section 36, lot 446, Minneapolis, MN, about 1944.

**General:** CHURCH: Åtvidaberg kyrka, founded in the 15th century, was probably the church that she and her parents and siblings attended when they lived nearby(Photographs: 15-24 July 2003, Sweden, roll#4 frames 8-10). There is no evidence of family members buried there. All members of her family except Carolina Lovisa immigrated to the USA where they were buried. Carolina was probably buried in Dalhem, Kalmar län which was not visited during July 2003, but it was visited on 13 Jul 2005. The main building and the forum was restored in 1885. There is an old pipe organ present.

IMMIGRATION: Sara (age 18) arrived in USA with father(Jonas Peter Carlsson, age 63), mother(Lena Zachrisdotter, age 56), sister(Emilia Augusta, age 21), and brother(August Swan age 25) in 1880, but the exact date is uncertain. Their destination was Hastings, Dakota Co., Minnesota. They were present in Vermillion, Dakota Co., MN on 18 June 1880 for the 1880 Federal Census. Their names in the Census were John Peter Carlson, Hellon? Carlson, Swan August Johnson, Emilia A. Johnson, and Sarah M. Johnson. The Passenger lists of vessels arriving in New York were each examined at least twice for ships arriving between May 4-12, 1880 (Roll#425), May 13-24, 1880, (Roll #426), and May 25-June 18, (Roll #427) and Jonas and his family were not found. An Index to the Passenger lists of vessels arriving in New York and prepared by Ancestry.com revealed a Jonas Carlson (without an age given), but no other members of his family that Left Göteborg with him were among the list of passengers. Shelly Robert Johnson believes that this Jonas Carlson was not Jonas Petter Carlsson. It appears they may have landed at a port other than New York, perhaps Canada. A search of the Passenger lists for other ports in the USA did not include any of these people. However the Passenger lists need to be rechecked for the names found in the 1880 Census. Only one child, Carolina, stayed in Sweden. She married (age 24) in 1870 and established a family and their many descendents now live in Sweden today. The other two children immigrated previously to the USA, Christina in 1869, age 25, and Per Johan Oscar in 1870, age 20.
